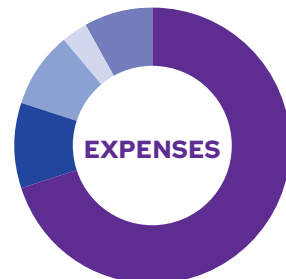
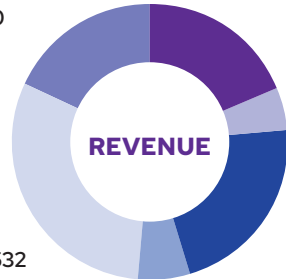

## Celebrating Compassion in Action

**“The Community Preschool immerses my son in a welcoming environment of cultural diversity. We are grateful that the cathedral’s commitment to inclusivity embraces our youngest San Franciscans.”**

Our financial commitment equips our clergy to nurture our spiritual lives, expand our outreach, and champion social justice initiatives.

Each month, our Stories from Mom and Dad ministry brings comfort and connection to 100 children of incarcerated parents in San Francisco County jails by sending books along with recordings of their parents reading aloud.

Twice a month, Dinner with Grace volunteers bring nourishment and kindhearted connection to our neighbors in nearby single-room occupancy hotels by preparing and serving meals made from scratch.

Every summer, volunteers purchase and fill 150 backpacks with school supplies and distribute them to children in the Bayview-Hunters Point neighborhood and at The Community Preschool.

Year-round, our thriving Children, Youth, and Families Ministry equips families to explore their faith journey together, deepening their understanding of the Church’s beliefs and traditions.

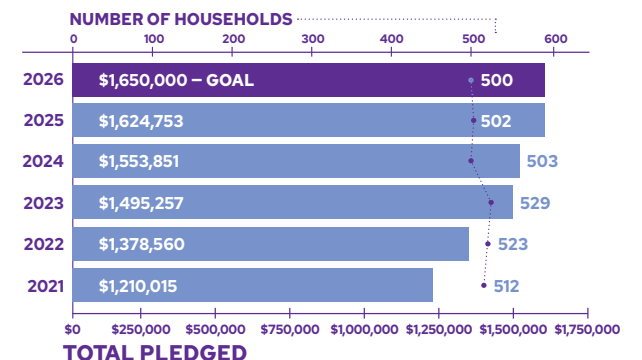
